Known for its long spa tradition, Budapest has an array of thermal spas ranging from historic Turkish and medieval baths to the more modern. Visit two of the most popular spas in the city - the medicinal Széchenyi Baths and the art-deco style Gellert Spa. While in Budapest, make the most of the wealth of historical and cultural attractions by cruising down the Danube or spending a night at the opera.

Guests can explore Helsinki's many museums by day, including the fascinating National Museum of Finland, before wandering around the markets in the evening. Leonardo 500: Da Vinci in Florence - from £698 pp with Kirker Holidays\*

Birthplace of the Renaissance, Florence's cultural credentials step even further into the spotlight in 2019 as the city marks the 500<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Leonardo da Vinci's death. At the Uffizi Gallery, a new room hosting his paintings opened in July and an exhibition of the Codex Leicester (a collection of his scientific writings, on loan from Bill Gates) runs from **29 October until 20 January 2019**, with further displays planned at the Galileo Museum. Celebrate the life of one of the world's most important thinkers, inventors and artists during a <a href="mailto:three-night stay">three-night stay</a> just a few minutes from the Duomo. The price is from £698 pp (two sharing), including flights (Gatwick), private car transfers, B&B accommodation, a guaranteed entrance ticket to the Uffizi, Kirker's Guide Notes to restaurants, museums & sightseeing, and the services of the Kirker Concierge. #### Sarajevo: The link between East and West Bosnia - from £720 pp with Kudu Travel\*

Explore Bosnia's enchanting capital, Sarajevo, on the fascinating walking tour, <u>Sarajevo and Mostar</u>, where you can learn about the city's complex history from a specialist local guide over a cup of Bosnian coffee, before a tour of the historical city centre, passing through the many multi-cultural monuments and ancient bazaars. Visit Baščaršija, the centre of the old Ottoman town, with its 16<sup>th</sup> Century Gazi Husrey Beg Mosque, the renovated *caravanserai* (roadside inn) Morića Han, and the spot where Archduke Franz Ferdinand was assassinated, an event widely acknowledged as sparking the First World War. Enjoy day trips to the highland village of Lukomir and home of the world-famous fully-restored medieval bridge, Mostar. **Departing between 1 May and 30 September 2019**, this trip costs from £720 pp (two sharing), including four nights' accommodation, guide, transfers and activities. Attend the Conservation and Heritage Symposium in Liverpool – from £580 pp with Martin Randall With more listed buildings than any other UK city outside of London, Liverpool is the perfect location for Martin Randall Travel's 2018 symposium; Conservation and Heritage: Champions and Challenges.
