This aqueduct is part of the Pythagorean archaeological site, a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1992, which can now be visited in its entirety, including the Heraion of Samos – a large sanctuary dedicated to Hera, the goddess of marriage, women, childbirth and family. Visitors can now enjoy one of the most rewarding travel experiences in Greece on the eastern Aegean island of Samos.

The Hungarian Tourism Agency invites everyone to the <u>Gourmet Festival 2018</u>. This finest festival of Hungarian gastronomy will go beyond the borders of the country this year by introducing not only some of the best restaurants in the region, but also inviting guest chefs from neighbouring countries.
