Departing 2017 and 2018

Activities Abroad* has a **new** holiday based in a new destination: <u>Saariselkä, Finnish</u> <u>Lapland</u>. Sleep under the Arctic stars in a glass-roofed Aurora Cabin for the perfect tailor-made winter family adventure, hunting the Northern Lights. Bespoke activities include husky sledding, cross-country skiing, Aurora snowmobiling, a reindeer sleigh ride and much more. *Departing between December 2017 and March 2018*.
