In the Footsteps of Indian Independence – from Delhi to Amritsar is a special historical journey, linking key locations from the latter days of British rule in India, the events surrounding partition and the evolution of modern India in the post-independence period. *Departing between now and December 2018.* 

**Simply Sweden**\* offers a new three-night <u>Christmas market in Jokkmokk escape</u>, including a Sami and reindeer excursion, in Swedish Lapland. Indigenous Sami people have been travelling to Jokkmokk for over 400 years to sell their reindeer wares, warm clothing, jewellery, trinkets and crafts. This is an opportunity to visit a unique, authentic and culturally-sensitive Christmas Market. *Departs 7 December 2017*.

**The Aurora Zone**\* has a new <u>three-night trip</u> in north-western Finland to discover the magnificent Northern Lights under atmospheric autumn skies. With expert guides, learn the secrets of the Lights by campfire, seek the phenomenon by mountain bike through Harriniva's vibrant landscapes, and enjoy tranquil forests and lakes which reflect both the autumn colours and the Lights; a magical setting for an aurora adventure. *Departures from 28 August to 20 September 2017*

A grand prize winner will receive return train tickets to Barcelona with two nights of eco-friendly accommodation in Catalonia.

**The Macao Government Tourism Office** presents <u>Cinematheque • Passion</u> – a brand-new cinema, film centre and library designed to promote film culture to film lovers around the world. Taking its name from its location in famed *Travessa da Paixão* (Love Lane) and situated next to the iconic Ruins of St. Paul's in Santo António – enjoy different thematic film festivals and programmes every month, plus two local short/feature films two weekends a month, free of charge.

**The Malta Tourism Authority** announces that <u>Phoenicia Malta</u> has reopened in Floriana, just outside the capital of Valletta, following an extensive €15-million refurbishment. As well as interior upgrades, a new inifinity pool and re-designed grounds, new Café Phoenicia will be unveiled in August, and a health club and spa will open in late 2017. Enjoy views of the Bastian Walls, Renzo Piano's City Gate and the Triton's Fountain from the café's terrace.

The National Spanish Tourist Board announces that 2017 marks the 40th anniversary of the first LGBTIQ pride parade in Spain. <u>WorldPride Madrid 2017</u> is the global LGBTIQ Pride festival to be held in the neighbourhood of *Chueca* and the main streets of Madrid from 23 June to 2 July. Expect open air concerts, a range of stages, parties, art, culture, sport and more. This is a great festival to celebrate, discuss and showcase diversity, culminating in the World Pride Parade, which will be the world's largest Pride parade ever.

**The Tenerife Tourism Corporation** claims that music history will be made on **Saturday 8 July** when American rock band Aerosmith plays its final European concert at the Heliodoro Rodríguez López Stadium in <u>Santa Cruz</u>. Tickets are still available for the *Aero-Vederci Baby!* tour, and this performance is considered to be one of the most important musical events in the Canary Islands in the last three decades.

**VisitGuernsey** welcomes the return of the Guernsey Food Festival from **16 to 24 September**. Celebrating the quality and variety of island food, local producers and chefs will showcase exceptional produce from Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Sark. Enjoy special bar and restaurant promotions, gastronomic tours, chef masterclasses, street markets and more. Taste Guernsey will be running a <u>series of mini-festivals</u> celebrating local food in the lead-up to the festival.

**West Sweden Tourist Board** invites curious travellers to '<u>meet the locals</u>' and experience the Swedish lifestyle.
