## **Departing 2017 and 2018**

Staying in a cosy winter cottage with wood-burning stove and private sauna, families will hunt the Northern Lights by snowshoe, dine in an ice restaurant, meet friendly reindeer, and embark on husky and snowmobile safaris. **Departs 26th December 2017.** 

Adagio\* – the experts in "gentle walking" small-group expert-led holidays – has launched its new 2018 brochure with a selection of magical trips including 'Mediterranean Switzerland', with its palm-fringed lakes, 'The Romantic Heart of Spain' featuring the ancient cities of Segovia and Toledo, and 'Magnificent Mont Blanc', exploring France's Chamonix Valley. Departing between 25 June and 10 September 2018.
